At the southern terminus of CN's North American network, Louisiana handles growing volumes of traffic, notably in the triangle formed by Hammond, Baton Rouge and the Port of New Orleans. CN's major yards are in Baton Rouge, Geismar and Harahan (Mays Yard) outside of New Orleans. At Mays Yard, CN connects to the New Orleans Public Belt Railroad, which links the city's six Class I railroads. CN also has a modern intermodal facility in New Orleans. Amtrak's *City of New Orleans* service terminates in New Orleans.

Network Investments

Over the past decade, CN has invested more than US\$608 million in rail capacity, safety and intermodal improvements on its Class I railroad system in Louisiana. These capital investments are supporting a stronger, more vibrant economy in Louisiana through transportation that is safer and more efficient. The expansion program included double-tracking sidings at the Convent Marine Terminal, replacing the Baton Rouge Bridge, and rebuilding the McComb Spillway Bridge. The maintenance program focused on the replacement of rail and ties, plus upkeep of crossings, bridges, culverts, signal systems and other track infrastructure.

Community Investments

In 2025, CN contributed to several Louisiana-based organizations, including:

BUCHANAN COUNTY Support from CN helped strengthen the Buchanan County Sheriff's Office Drone Program through equipment upgrades that enhance search and rescue operations, aerial observation, and other mission-critical public safety activities.

FOOD BANK OF CENTRAL LOUISIANA CN contributed a flagship donation to the Food Bank of Central Louisiana, helping expand efforts to alleviate hunger and break the cycle of food insecurity across the region.

BOYS TOWN LOUISIANA CN helped advance Boys Town Louisiana's Successful Futures program, which equips vulnerable young adults with life skills and workforce-readiness training to support sustainable employment and long-term career success.
